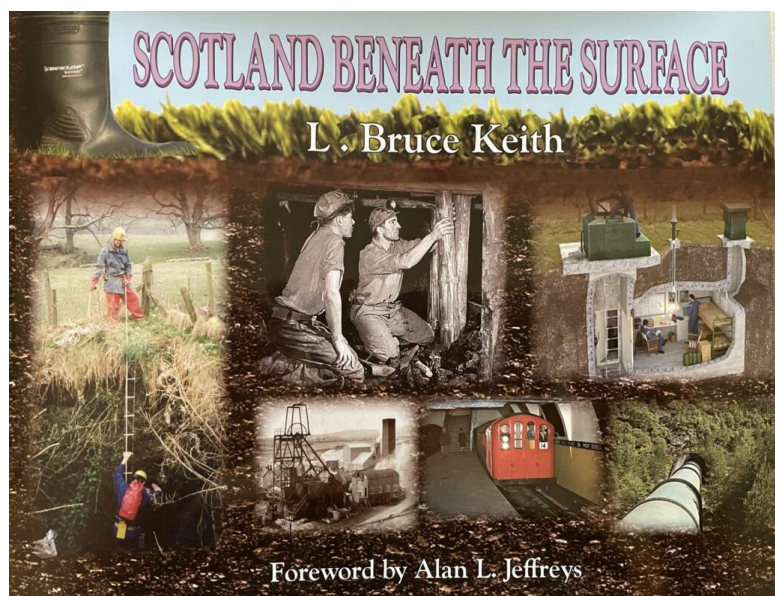
There will be spare seats on the coach for any member who would like to go shopping in Milton Keynes. Again, please contact Wendy.
